## CITIZEN INPUT NEEDED

Citizen input played an important part in the development of Pelican Park. In 1996, when the need for expansion of the original 50 acre park was evident, the Board of Commissioners created a citizen committee to help determine what should be included in the expansion. The committee was open to any person interested. The committee spent many hours meeting, listening to different sport needs and deciding what to build. The Board of Commissioners followed the citizen committee's recommendations with the development of the present Park. The Board of Commissioner's Strategic planning committee hired Ivan Miestchovich, UNO expert, to project the future demographics and population of the Recreation District. The committee also hired Ken Ballard of Ballard-King Parks and Recreation Consultants to help determine the number of fields, gyms and facilities that would be needed based upon the projected demographics. As part of these studies, the District is asking the public for their input via an on-line survey. The survey takes less than 5 minutes and will provide vital information about what our citizens want for the experts to use in their study.

## Did you know?.....

- The Park operates its own water system. We have two wells and staff certified and trained to operate and maintain a public water system. The Park produces 77 million gallons of water a year. The District spends over \$55,000.00 a year on well operations to provide the water for drinking, bathrooms and irrigation of the fields.
- Field irrigation uses 12,000 gallons of water per day in order to irrigate the 32 fields for 30 minutes.
- The Castine Center turned 10 years old this year. This building hosts most of the major fundraisers and Mardi Gras balls in the area. Usage has exceeded expectations. The building is booked over 80% of the time on weekends. The building can hold 1,600 people for a sit down dinner or 2,500 in chairs only event.
- The Park's sports hotline (626-1444) that provides updated field conditions originated at the Park 18 years ago. The hotline concept is now utilized by most other Recreation Districts as well as Parks across the nation.
- Doug McLemore, Park Superintendent, Kia Knight, Assistant Director and Ann Keyes, Recreation Superintendent all celebrate 10 years of service to the Recreation District this year.
